

THE KEY FINDINGS FROM THE NON-FATAL DROWNING INCIDENTS IN OUR STUDY



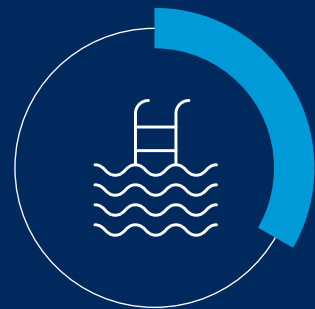
79%

of children included in the study were 0-4 years old



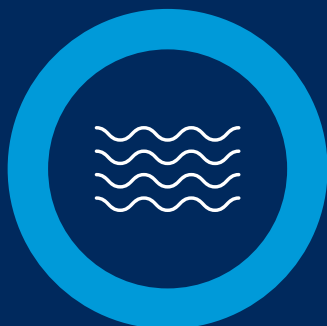
34%

of children 0-16 years old were from a culturally and linguistically diverse background



36%

of children 0-16 years old experienced a non-fatal drowning in swimming pools, followed by 23% in baths



Children who were unsupervised accounted for the highest number of drowning incidents, the majority of these occurring in swimming pools



68%

of children 0-4 years old were unsupervised at the time of the incident



74%

of children who needed CPR were unsupervised at the time they were in the water



33%

of incidents in private swimming pools occurred because the pool gate was propped open



85%

of children were found by a family member



49%

of children had water familiarisation or swimming lessons prior to the drowning incident
